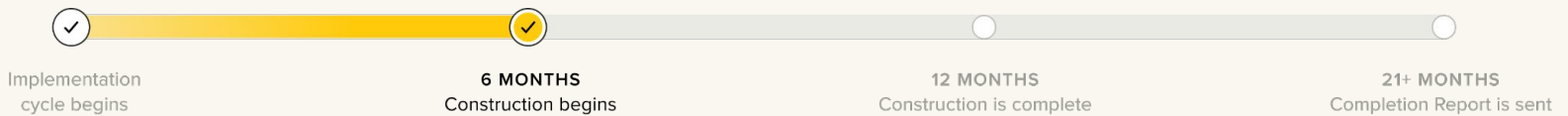




Your First Progress Report is Here



Progress To Date

Your funds were sent to our local partners in July, and the following six months are considered the planning stages of project implementation. Preparation is one of the most important stages of this process. Our partners use this time to assess and select which communities or schools will receive water points based on factors such as geography, need, community interest, the risk of overlap with other organizations, and the availability of spare parts for future repairs. Once the school or community locations are determined, water point management training begins and construction materials are transported to the site.

What's next?

In the next few months, the construction will accelerate. Once construction is complete, our local implementing partners will test the water quality and hand the projects over to the communities for ongoing maintenance and management. Meanwhile, trainings will take place covering topics such as sustainability, sanitation, and hygiene. We can't wait to share even more details in your next report!



About your sponsorship in Malawi

Since 2012, charity: water has supported World Vision Malawi's water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) programming, which is currently focused in Ntcheu District. Here, World Vision Malawi is implementing new wells that are fitted with Afridev hand pumps and capable of reaching Malawi's low water table. They are also building mechanized piped systems that draw water from deep boreholes into elevated storage tanks and then use gravity to distribute the clean water to community tap stands.

Thanks to all of these efforts and the support of the government's District Council, World Vision Malawi plans to achieve full WASH coverage in the Ntcheu District by 2026.
